

## Winning Wheels Indoor Visitation Policy and Procedures

**POLICY STATEMENT:** It is Winning Wheels intent to assist family and residents to connect using the safest means necessary during the COVID-19 Pandemic. Visits will be allowed as long as Whiteside County's positivity rate is less than 10% and no facility outbreak (One positive test result of a staff or resident). **Be advised that outdoor visits are still preferred to indoor visits, weather permitting.**

### **PROCEDURE:**

- 1) **Visits must be made with the Social Worker.** Visitors must provide their own facemask to be worn during the entire visit, and 6 feet social distancing must be maintained from staff and other residents/visitors, even if vaccinated.
- 2) Visits are scheduled Monday- Friday, and weekends as requested.
- 3) Number of visitors will be allowed for space available to maintain a 6 foot separation.
- 4) Indoor visits are limited to the designated area only. **Visitors may not walk around facility to different halls in facility.**
- 5) Visitors will enter thru the front entrance and must self-screen.
- 6) Visitors should not visit if they are ill. If any visitor develop symptoms of COVID-19 within three days after visiting, they must immediately notify the facility.
- 7) No residents in isolation or quarantine can receive visitors.
- 8) Visits may be cancelled or ended early due to current restrictions put in place by IDPH or by visitors refusing to follow the facility's policy during the visit. If in doubt, please contact a Social Worker before you come.
- 9) If a new case of COVID-19 is identified, indoor and outdoor visits will be paused until one round of testing of residents and staff can be completed.
- 10) Trips outside the building are allowed with family/friends. Please schedule these with the Social Worker. Residents should maintain physical distancing, wear a cloth facemask or face covering, and hand hygiene throughout time spent at the destination and to avoid crowds and poorly ventilated spaces.
- 11) If residents are out of the building overnight, when they return they must quarantine for 14 days, regardless of vaccination status.
